Subject:	<p>Request from the Chief Judge to discard the rule A.9 in the Competition Rules Addendum A.</p> <p>”For the speed event there must be an electronic device to display the achieved time synchronised with the Speed Timing System or the Scoring System. It should be located close to the course visible to competitors and spectators.”</p> <p>The organiser for this competition do not have the means to achieve this.</p>
Details:	<p>In the bid the organiser advised the ISC that they would be using the same scoring system as 2019.</p>
Decision:	<p>The jury deliberated on the request to waive the requirements for an electronic device to display scores in the speed event. It was considered that the display in question does not show official times or scores which have been approved or reviewed by a judge. The display also does not represent a critical part of the scoring system necessary to insure accurate or timely running of the competition. With these considerations, and that the speed event can be conducted without any diminished integrity to the running of the event, scoring of the event, or record, the jury approves allowing the competition to begin without adherence to rule A.9 from Addendum A.</p>
